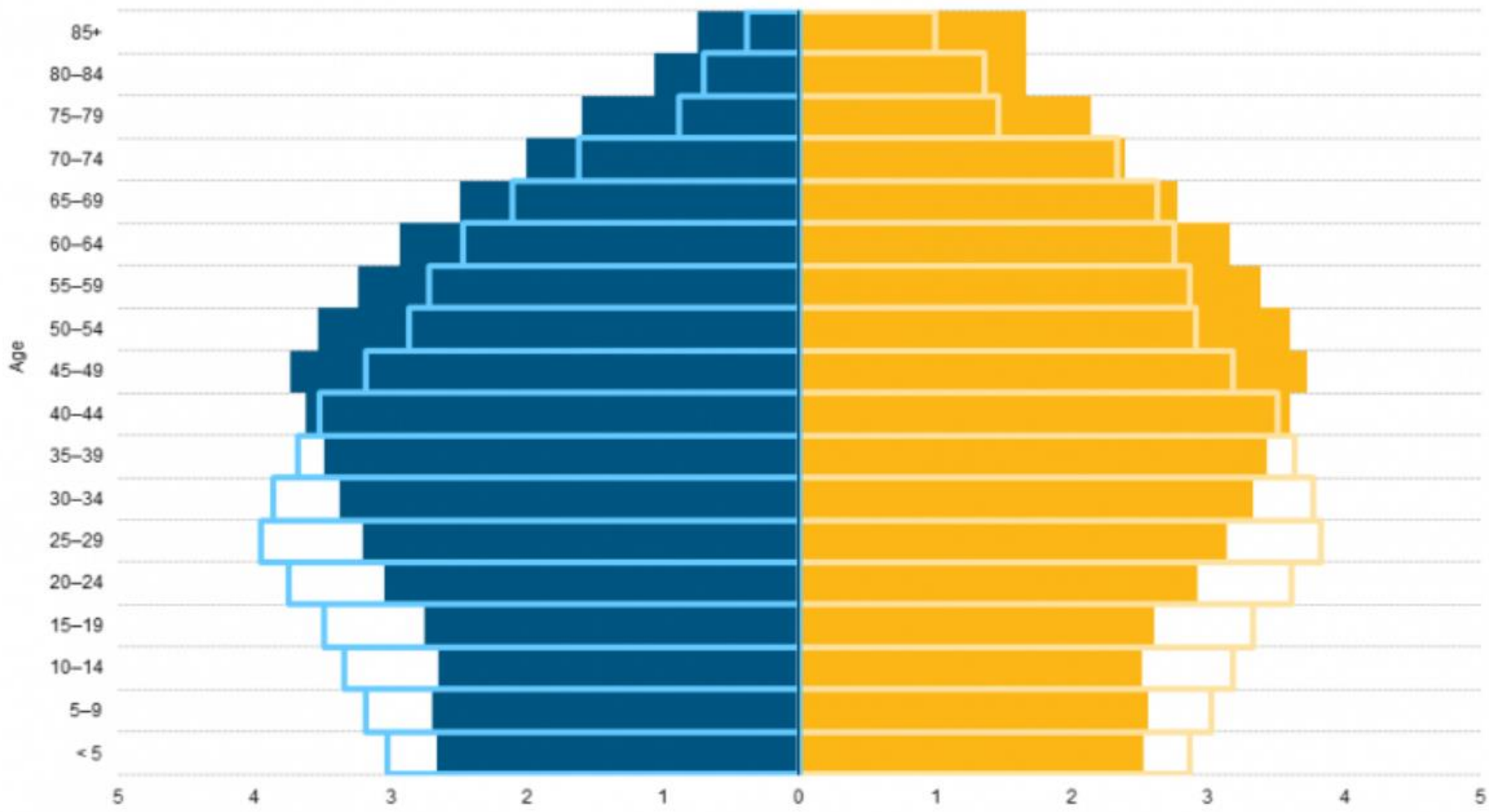


Warum dieses Thema

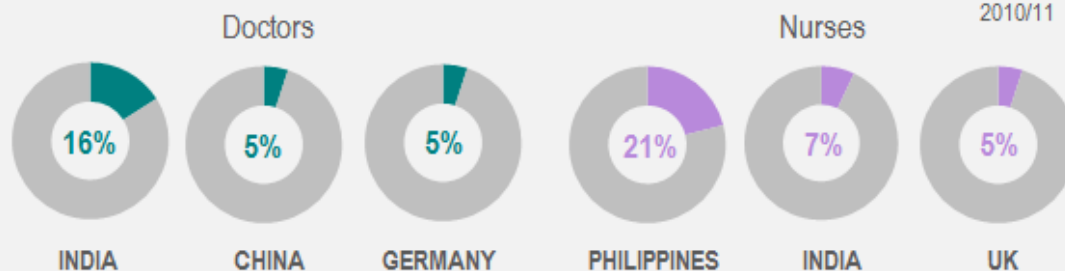

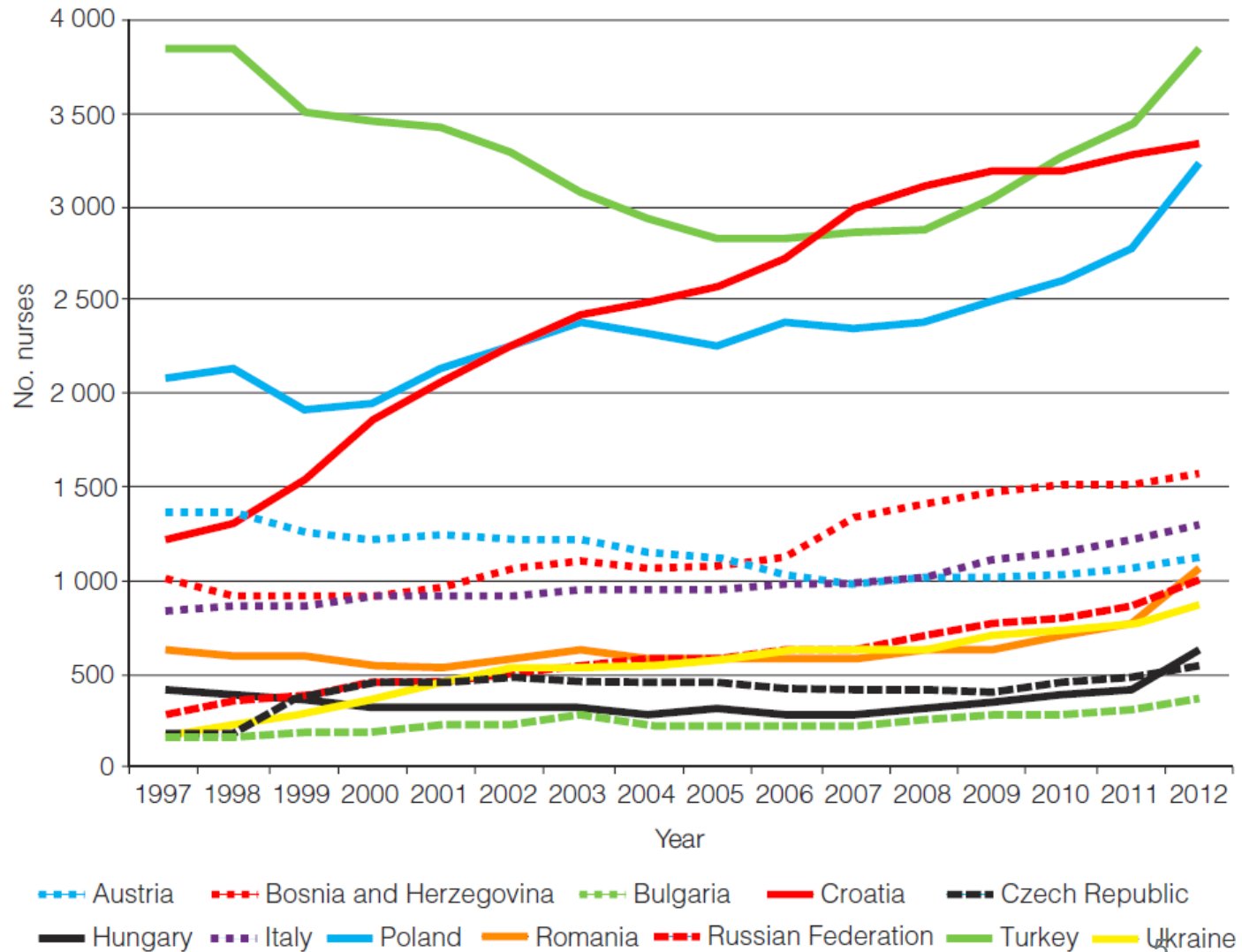
